Buildings and Grounds ST 1-Cmrs. Bragg and DiLorenzo

<u>Verizon Micro-Cell</u>-Commissioner Bragg reported that there would be no penetration to the roof when the micro-cell tower is installed. Verizon will pay the Highland Fire District approximately \$6000 annually.

<u>St.1 No Heat</u>- Chairman Dilorenzo reported that there was no heat on the east side of the building. Airflow was called in and an ignitor was replaced. Bills just came in.

<u>Security System Cameras</u>-Chairman DiLorenzo stated that Kevin Wilhelm of Safeco has prepared a proposal for us. The Lloyd Police Department is willing to contribute to this project as well as Mobile Life Support Service. All Equipment is ordered, and hopefully we can get this project done this year. Commissioner Bragg stated that we should look at a security system for Station 2.
