1. **Opening of meeting**- Chairman DiLorenzo called the meeting to order, led the pledge of allegiance to the flag and called for a moment of silence for fallen firefighters.

Report from Focused Wealth Management-Phil DeAngelo

Chairman DiLorenzo dispensed with the normal order of business to permit Phil DeAngelo of Focused Wealth Management to present a report on our LOSAP funding status. Mr. DeAngelo discussed an analysis of investment positions. He stated that the markets have gotten rough in the last few days. Chairman DiLorenzo stated that he spoke with Tony Hill and based on our numbers we are about 72% funded with \$ 1.4 million in assets. Mr. De Angelo stated that we may be approaching 75 %. Commissioner Fraino stated that if we have a drawdown of 3.8 % with a growth of 6 %, then our net growth is 3%. Mr. DeAngelo stated that we are in good shape with 45 to 55 % in fixed income bonds. Mr. DeAngelo stated that he would like to come back in when we have the numbers from Penflex. Mr. DeAngelo noted that biotech is down 20% in the past 2 weeks with utilities up 30%. Chairman Dilorenzo thanked Mr. DeAngelo for the update.

3. New Member Interviews/Approvals-Chairman DiLorenzo noted that we need to interview the new Officers as well as a new member, Francis Stevens. The Board decided to interview Francis Stevens first.

Chairman DiLorenzo stated that he would be on probation for 1 year. Commissioner John Fraino thanked Francis for volunteering and advised him to follow the instructions of the officers.

Commissioner Palladino advised Francis that in the event of injury related to firematic duty, Highland Fire District is considered his employer. Chairman DiLorenzo thanked Francis for coming.

6. Committee Reports:

Buildings and Grounds: St. 1 Commissioners Bragg and DiLorenzo

<u>ST.1 Walls</u>-Chairman DiLorenzo stated that painting is needed on the walls throughout the firehouse as well as in the community room. Chairman DiLorenzo stated that he would like to contact George Ottaviano. Board agreed.

Audio Visual Upgrade Proposal-Chairman DiLorenzo stated that the proposal includes wireless video, 137" screen, speakers, cordless microphone, option for live stream and wireless connection. Cost is \$11450. Because it would be an upgrade to the community room, 1/3 of the cost could be charged against the community room expenses. Equipment is on NYS contract. Commissioner Fraino asked about maintenance fees if any. Chairman DiLorenzo stated that there are no on-going maintenance fees. Two outlets would be installed in the ceiling; this would be a two day install. Chairman DiLorenzo stated that he would obtain another quote even though this pricing is based on NYS contract pricing.

<u>AIRFLOW</u>-There were questions regarding the biannual check sheet. District Clerk obtained information and sent it to the Board via email.

<u>New York Blood Center</u>- Chairman DiLorenzo stated that a letter was received again regarding the NY Blood Center Blood Drive that was held in recent months. Chairman DiLorenzo stated that they understand how we felt about the condition of the room when they left, however we are not seeking reimbursement.

Overhanging Limbs St 2- Chairman DiLorenzo stated that D & D has started cleaning up the grounds at St

Generators-Chairman Dilorenzo stated they are due for service.

<u>Mold-</u> Chairman DiLorenzo stated that he contacted the company to get a quote for cleaning both stations.

<u>Dutchess Overhead Doors</u>- it was noted that they were notified to do maintenance agreement next year.

- **8. Insurance** It was reported that the Tank Insurance rider would be at a cost of \$500. Board wanted to know limits. District clerk will contact agent for further information.

- **14. Treasurer Report** Treasurer Passikoff reported that we are under budget with our big items. The fund balance to be appropriated is \$44647. Our snow plow bills are all in.

- **16. Public Comment** Various members of the Highland Hose company commented on the possible venues for the Inspection Dinner.
- **17. Chief's Report** Chief Miller reported that we may switch 31-80 and 31-C; as 31-c is having some problems. If 80 becomes C, we will need to update lighting. We can't order the 2015 model until Fall and we are looking at State Bid. The check Engine Light keeps coming on as some O-rings need to be repaired.

Grant Status- Chief Miller will follow up.

SCBA- we are evaluating with MES.

Radios- Chief Miller reported that we are working on frequencies and meeting with NYCOMCO. At the recent FAST drill the MT100 (circa 1980) radios were horrible; it really could be dangerous at a real scene. Marlboro to sell some radios; we may wish to purchase for interim use.

Ladies Auxiliary-are crunched for space.

Motorola- Chief Miller reported that they are doing away with low band. The drop-dead date for low band dispatching is May 2016, if this is true this would be a \$24000 cost to replace the low band pagers with high band pagers. May 2016 was selected to allow agencies to have several budget cycles to plan; Chief feels it should be 5 budget cycles to make the cost more manageable.

Duty Day-has been implemented. Contact Mike Gaffney for list of duties to be performed and two people are needed.

Knox Box-There is a new agreement to sign regarding key security.

CSX-materials have been sent out.

FF1 Class-April 19, 2014 Kerhonkson will be here.
