The meeting was called to order at 7:04 PM. The Minutes were reviewed and accepted with 2 changes.

The banner that the rotary provided and paid for is in and ready to be hung next week. Carol T. will contact the fire department about getting it installed. She is also going to go to all the schools on Mammoth Road and ask them to advertise our slogan on their marquee signs for a few weeks. This would coincide with the banner hanging across Mammoth Road. We will follow up with Kathy Wagner about getting an article on Londonderrynh.Net and to have them tweet to encourage people to pitch in and clean up a designated area. We will have instructions and/or get supplies to the groups (flash volunteers) and ask them to take a photo of their group near the trash bags for advertising. A rep from our group would meet the group – likely at the high school – each Saturday to distribute supplies.

John L, Andy M, and Carol T plan to attend the race that taking place on Saturday. Carol T, along with her husband, will be standing at the end of Tokanel Road to hand out water. Carol T will check with Caron about where John and Andy can help out. The race starts at 2 PM. They are anticipating about 400 people to participate in the race.

We will also check with businesses other than the schools and churches who have marquee signs who would be willing to advertise the slogan, "Londonderry Pride: Pick It Up – March 20 – April 15".

The design of the window decals will be: Londonderry Roadside Pride – "Pick It Up" with the text "We Support" above the slogan. We will put an apple on the left side and an anti-littering graphic on the right. Kerri will draft a design and email it to the committee members.

We need to check with the town about getting business cards or something that identifies us as legitimate members of the committee. Kerri will check with Margo about this.
