Carol T asked neighbor, Sharon Carson about a bottle bill and Sharon said there is a lot of red tape and it gets vetoed very quickly. As good a cause as it is, there is a good amount of cost associated with recycling.

We don't think that adding anti-littering road signs will deter people from littering, unfortunately.

We would like to have a booth at Old Home Days this year. We would need to use Beautify LDerry funds to secure a booth. Kerri will bring it up at the next BL meeting. We perhaps could get kids to carry the Roadside Pride sign in the parade. Carol will check with the OHD Committee about fees, etc.
