23	K. Wagner stated because the house was built in 1799, they wanted to see if
24	there was anything worth preserving for Londonderry.

26	Tom Monahan, managing member of Perkins Farm LLC, the owner of 48
27	Perkins Road, addressed the committee and mentioned he has only been in the
28	house a couple of times since the Van Steensburgs' moved out in the beginning
29	of October, but his concern right now is life safety issues. He is more than



willing to work with the Demolition Delay committee and the Historic District
