- On Thursday, March 26, 2009, at 7:00 p.m., the library will host "Attracting Birds and Butterflies to Your Garden" with Michelle Mensinger. This informative program will feature a variety of ways to create a garden that will attract birds and butterflies. The program will include a bird and butterfly trivia contest with bags of bird seed as prizes, as well as a hand-made birch suet feeder. The Friends of the Londonderry Leach Library will be sponsoring the program.
- On Thursday, April 16, 2009, at 7:00 p.m., the library will have a presentation by John Rockwood on "Understanding and Respecting New England Wildlife". Local photographer John Rockwood will present a narrated slideshow featuring photos and facts about wildlife found in New England, including loons, harbor seals, bald eagles, and hummingbirds. The photos will include a number taken at Squam Lakes Science Center and on Plum Island. The Friends of the Londonderry Leach Library will be sponsoring the program.

Assistant Director and Head of Circulation Services Report:

- During the month of January, circulation increased more than 5% over January 2008. The Adult Room circulated more than 13,800 items, and the Children's Room circulated more than 8,600 items, for a combined total of 22,485 items.
- The Children's Room staff answered 497 Reference questions during January, and offered 15 programs to 397 participants.
- On President's Day I visited the High School to take part in a discussion of *The Legacy of Abraham Lincoln*, with Kelly Oaks' Senior AP History class. This was one of the programs that I organized for the *We the People* grant, to promote reading and discussion on the relevance of Abraham Lincoln's policies today. It has been edited, and will be shown on the school cable channel. I would like to thank Kelly Oaks, her students and Sue Ballard for their help with this program.
- On Wednesday, February 18, 2009, John McDonough and his Pumpernickel Puppets entertained children with a presentation of *The Frog Prince*. Within a couple of days of sign-up starting, all 75 spaces were filled, and we had a waiting list of an additional 30 names.
- The Children's Room is offering a scavenger hunt during February school vacation. Pick up a scavenger item list from the Children's Room, and return them this week, through Saturday, February 28. Participants will receive a raffle ticket for a chance to win a prize.

- On Monday, March 9, 2009, Dyan deNapoli, the Penguin Lady, will be presenting an exciting program about penguins. Advance registration is required and begins on Monday, March 2. The program is open to 75 participants of all ages.
- Nilla the Therapy Dog and her owner Trish Hamann will be coming by the library on Wednesday, March 11, from 3:30-4:30 p.m. To reserve a 15-minute slot, call the Children's Room beginning on Monday, March 2.

Assistant Director and Head of Reference Services Report:

- There were 902 items cataloged in January and 568 items discarded.
- The reference staff answered 835 reference questions in January and logged 675 people onto the Internet.
- January, February, and March are our busiest times for tax forms. They are going quickly so I have ordered more of the basic forms and instructions.
- March is Women's History Month and we will highlight famous women and the Women's movement on the large table.
- On the small table we will feature television and mass media and their effect on our lives.

New Business:

• <u>Right-to-Know-Laws-</u>

Barbara Ostertag-Holtkamp distributed copies of a DVD on the Right-to-Know-Law. She also passed around a bound printed copy of the New Hampshire Attorney General's memorandum on New Hampshire's Right-to-Know-Laws.

• Magazine Gift List-

Barbara Ostertag-Holtkamp reported that she has been contacted by Michael Bouldin from Premier Media Concepts with a list of magazines. The library would select 8 to 16 magazines from the list, and Mr. Bouldin would find businesses to sponsor the subscription. In exchange the library would have to display new issues in binders with an advertisement for the sponsor in a front pocket in each binder. This conflicts with many of our policies that deal with promotional materials and commercial enterprises. The Board decided that this was contrary to library policies, so they do not want the Library Director to pursue it.
