- On May 5, 2016, the sprinkler backflow prevention was inspected. It passed inspection. However, deficiencies were noted during the sprinkler inspection. There was a recalled sprinkler head in the elevator room and an additional sprinkler head needed to be installed in the small closet in the meeting room. The work was completed on May 23, 2016.
