# **Old Business:**

• FY19-20 Proposed Budget

Barbara Ostertag-Holtkamp distributed two spreadsheets of the Proposed FY19-20 Budget. The first was in accordance with previous practice, and the second follows the known directives for a default budget. Barbara Ostertag-Holtkamp spoke to Doug Smith, Finance Director, and there are unanswered questions regarding the new law concerning default budgets. A discussion ensued. Town Council Liaison, Joe Green stated that the Town Council is looking into how the budget will be handled this year.

• Heated sidewalk estimates

Barbara Ostertag-Holtkamp distributed the estimate for the heated sidewalk in front of the library. The total estimate is approximately \$60,000.00. Barbara Ostertag-Holtkamp was concerned about the high cost and she emailed Steve Cotton to obtain a lower cost option. Steve Cotton is looking into a cost estimate for taking up and replacing the six panels of concrete in front of the library and resetting the granite stairs. Once this was completed, replacement of the concrete ramp would be done at a later date. Barbara Ostertag-Holtkamp is waiting for the estimate.

A **motion** was made by John Curran to not install a heated sidewalk. The **motion was seconded** by Cynthia Peterson. All in attendance accepted the motion, **motion carried**.

# New Business:

• <u>Tree pruning</u>

Barbara Ostertag-Holtkamp received the estimate of \$2,890.00 for phase 1 of the proposed tree pruning from Lee Gilman Associates. John Curran asked what had been done in the past to maintain the trees. Barbara Ostertag-Holtkamp responded that previously she has hired someone to prune the trees but at a much lower cost. A discussion ensued. John Curran stated that he does not think that the tree pruning is a priority at this time.
