LYSA is taking care of all this. The lights at the basketball courts at Nelson need to change to make more efficient energy. This will have a 10-12 year payback. Fixtures need to be repaired. There are two estimates/bids we are waiting on.
- 2. Equipment The budget freeze if off. The budget is set with the funds to purchase a hard cap with a heater for the tractor to keep warm in the fall and keep out of direct sun in the summer. The estimate cost for this is \$5180.
- 3. Budget is looking good with no major equipment breaks. Fertilizer will need to be purchased but no big expenditures.
- 4. High School outdoor summer basketball league will be put on hold until possibly 2016 when the high school coach, Nate Stanton, will have time to discuss details with LBC

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. There was a request from a mother to have reserved parking signs for people using the playground. It was decided that this cannot be enforced, everyone would be asking for reserved parking if this is started and there is not a way we can limit this to one specific group.
