- Acceptance of Minutes:
 - o Minutes from the April meeting were accepted unanimously
- Status of Solid Waste Contracts:
 - o Paul introduced Tom Lynch from Allied Waste. Tom is the recycling coordinator for Allied Waste.
 - o Tom discussed how the recycling aspects of our contract were going and said that the Town was doing great on handling the recycling program.
 - Tom discussed with the committee possible ways that we might be more successful in increasing our recycling rate such as pay-as-you throw, single stream, etc.
 - O Tom said that the one thing that he would like to see change is the use of plastic bags to hold the recyclables. The bags are a problem with the recycling equipment. He is also checking into why there is paper and commingles being mixed in the trucks.

• Poster Contest:

O Gail showed the committee that there were pictures in the local paper about the winners of the poster contest. The winners received movies tickets from Apple Tree Cinemas. She said that she had three posters left that had not been put on display and that she would find somewhere to place them.

- Welcome Signs:
