Acceptance of Minutes:

Minutes from the October meeting were accepted unanimously.

- Gary – ALAC met and discussed the installation of the new anti-litter road signs. Their Rotary meeting is put off till January 4.
- Marty – No facilities or vendors in the region are available at this time for recycling fry oil or composting commercial food waste, in terms of the Concord NH area. AMEICO is a future possibility. In terms of monument clean up, the contact is Steve Cotton at Town Hall
- Bob – Gotbooks brought the new, enlarged container but with the wrong configuration, so we're still waiting. He's still investigating recycling of small propane cans; it's an issue with respect to our Drop Off Center permit. Bob is waiting to hear from IT regarding the email broadcast list. He is still working on the NRRRA highlights.
- Hazardous Household Waste collection day is November 19th, 9 to noon. Waste oil will also be collected that same date, by Marty. Bob will get a mobile 5'x5' sign to promote it, to be placed by the library on Monday.
- Last Drop Off Center date: 11/19/11. DPW will look at extending the closing & opening dates in the future.
- The plastic recycling expansion publicity and transition was completed successfully
- Members noted that the Londonderry Times has been providing some great coverage of our programs and issues in papers.
- All members are welcome to contribute to or write our monthly Going Green in Londonderry column. Paul asked Bob to offer this to Donna Limoli as well.

- Paul informed the members that the Town Council were happy with the new Committee charter and name, and the Town Manager will draft a resolution for the changes.
- Paul requested ideas for 2012 Committee goals. We will continue the discussion next month.
- Paul to request Vinnie Curro film new videos of the HHW Day, Drop Off Center, and Curbside Recycling, since those programs have been upgraded since the last videos were produced.
