# Housekeeping & Misc.

- Paul discussed the Going Green columns and their status. Paul said that there are columns through the end of the year except for December.
- Paul issued the letter response to David Ellis regarding the request for a 65gallon recycling cart
- Paul issued the annual report to Kirby.
- The book donation bins are up and running and an article was in the paper regarding this matter.
- Lynn discussed using Facebook to help get out the committee's message. He showed the committee what he has done to date. Joy is also getting the committee's message out in Facebook on the MOMS Facebook page.
- KC Signs will be moving the Welcome Sign near the Backyard Brewery sometime this spring.

## Main Topics

Paul led a committee discussion on the upcoming compost bin sale. Paul will discuss the composting bin matter with Rick. Paul passed out a press release from 2009 when the committee last discussed buying compost bins. A discussion was had regarding how we would get the word out to the Town residents. Some of the communication outlets discussed were the Londonderry Times, the Committee's Facebook page, the Town Website, etc. The points we will try to get out will be: 1. What the committee is offering, 2. Benefits of composting, and 3. What it takes to compost. There was more discussion with Bob on how we might get the residents to sign up, where we could store the bins once we buy them, how do we distribute them.

- The committee discussed getting together with the Hudson Sustainability Committee to exchange ideas. Paul will set up a meeting with the committee. Duane, Rick and Paul were interested in attending.
- The committee had a plastic bag and film recycling discussion led by Paul. The
  committee is looking into arrangements to go to the individual supermarkets to
  discuss this with the store managers. Questions to be asked include who owns
  the film recycle containers, what is their process for handling full containers, what
  are the acceptable plastic film items that should be placed in the containers, etc.
- The committee went over the actions items and updated the list to remove and/or add certain action items.
- Duane, Paul and Gary all reupped their committee terms.
- Paul made an announcement that he was going to step down from the committee at the end of 2019. He asked the committee to be thinking about who might want to take over as Chairperson in early in 2019.
