Housekeeping & Main Topics

- Paul, Rick, Lynn, and Duane attended the February 25th Hudson Sustainability Committee meeting to exchange ideas. Paul, Rick, Lynn, and Duane give their input from that meeting to other committee members. Debbie Putnam from Hudson sat in on the meeting to listen to what our committee had to discuss. There was a good exchange of ideas and there are a lot of similarities between the Towns and what the committees are doing.
- The committee discussed the composting initiative and Rick gave a talk on his conversations with the NRRA and their expectations. The program is well in place for residents to sign up to get a composting bin and/or pail.
- Paul, Joy and Rick discussed the upcoming compost bin sale. Rick has gathered information from NRRA regarding the purchase and sale of compost bins from them. Paul submitted the article to the Londonderry Times on Friday the 15th and is waiting for it to run in the Londonderry Times. Bob will take care of getting the composting bin write up on to the Town web page.
- The committee discussed some NRRA training sessions being offered in Plymouth, NH on May 2, 2019, with topics regarding composting and batteries.
- Paul talked with Mike Byerly from the Beautify Londonderry (BL) and he informed Paul that a woman who attended the Londonderry Leadership training said that she would step into the role of running Beautify Londonderry. That person is Renee Williams. There will be a meeting next week regarding BL and trying to get a kick-off time frame.
- Future newspaper columns will include composting for the March column (Rick/Paul), the Conservation Commission will do the April column, which will focus on lawn care and the Committee will provide the May column (Joy) will be about the state of recycling today.
- The Girl Scouts will have a display board on voting day about recycling do's and don'ts and plastic film recycling. They will also be able to place the display in the first-floor lobby of Town Hall.
