OLD BUSINESS

Pumping Station – Matter tabled to the July 2017 meeting.

Rt 28 @ Stonehenge Road & Rt 128 @ Stonehenge, Bartley Hill & Litchfield Roads Intersections – These matters have been removed from the agenda at this time.

Rt 28 @ Sanborn Road – Superintendent Greenberg and Director of Buildings and Ground Zappala met with Town Manager Smith to discuss this issue. The School District is obtaining quotes on flashing lights for the school zone on Rt 28 @ Sanborn Road. The Police Department has put up radar signs for both north and southbound traffic in the school zone. The “trail” system will have lights at that intersection, DOT will be putting up a flashing beacon light going NB, and school district will be looking to put up 2 flashing school signs.
