Town Manager Smith advised the committee that this intersection is on the list to be reviewed by the NH Department of Transportation again. This matter was tabled to the January 2019 meeting.

King Area – Discussion took place regarding the “rotaries” on Otterson Rd in the area of the King Drives. These are not rotaries, they are stop signs along Otterson to deter the speeders, especially high school students after school.
