UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Route 28 & 128 – Flooding in the area has potentially been taken care of. Public Works Director Czyzowski advised the committee that grates have been installed to prevent beavers from building dams.

King Area – Matter is all set.

Hall and Mammoth Roads – No longer an issue.

Stonehenge Road- Public Works Director Czyzowski advised the job is almost complete.

Rt 128 @ Pillsbury Road – Matter has been tabled to April 1, 2019. John Trottier has been communicating with NH DOT.

Mammoth, Page & Grenier Field Roads – Discussion followed regarding this intersection, it was suggested adding a notification on the sign that it is a 2 way stop. Matter tabled to April meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Pasquale's - Route 102 – A discussion took place regarding the business owner requesting patrons not be allowed to take a left turn out of the parking lot, to go WB on Rt 102. Should the owner wish to post “no left turn” signs, the police department cannot enforce. It will be at the discretion of the business owner. Chairman Ramsay and Chief Hart will speak with business owner. Matter tabled to April Meeting.

High Range & Alexander Road – Don Turcotte explained to the committee of his concerns of speeding traffic on High Range Road. The committee advised that the speed limit was set top 30mph. Chief Hart advised he will assign patrol units to the area as well as radar units. He will have something put out via social media advising the residents. Matter tabled to April Meeting.

84 Pillsbury Road – Discussion took place regarding the curve. John Trottier advised he would contact the caller regarding more information regarding the issue. Matter tabled to April Meeting.
