1 Present: Deb Lievens, Gene Harrington, and Paul Nickerson

3 D. Lievens called the meeting to order at 7:35 PM but because only three members were in  
4 attendance, a quorum was not present.

6 Shoppes at Londonderry, 15-51 & 59- Prior to the meeting, this presentation was postponed until  
7 August 23.

8

9 Sunnycrest Phase I- In assigning this easement over to the Rockingham County Conservation District, a  
10 baseline report will be needed. D. Lievens obtained quotes from Chris Kane for \$600 and from RCCD  
11 for \$549. A vote can be taken when a quorum is present. A one-time donation to RCCD's stewardship  
12 fund would total \$7,319. D. Lievens will ask the Town Manager to place the issue on the August 15  
13 Town Council agenda so that they can vote to approve the transfer.

15 ARM grant- D. Lievens has learned that the Director of RCCD may be able to remove the invasive  
16 Phragmites species found on map and lot 6-113 as he has the proper aquatic license required to do so.

17 The final step in this project is to record the easement, which the Department of Environmental  
18 Services has signed, with the Registry of Deeds.

20 Merrill easement- This issue will be before the Town Council for their approval in September.
