#### **OLD BUSINESS**

## **OTHER BUSINESS**

- 1. Skate Park Project. The student running the project did not do any work. The school was contacted to inform them nothing was done. It's unlear what the status is of the monies that were raised for the project. It was suggested that moneies in budget could be used to do cleanup around the park.
