Comments from discussion:
  - We may need to order more sandwich boards since apparently some of ours weren't returned by BL volunteers in 2008. Can we use the DPW signs?
  - o Does the LPD have road way signs worth using?
  - We should provide tokens for the ALERT crews
  - Joel will again attempt to maintain the BL2011 project schedule on the internet
  - Plan is to release fundraising letters in Jan, & contact volunteer groups in Feb; we need to know their plans early to help us plan support resources
  - Funding constraints will prohibit us from hiring police details for road escorts
  - Mike suggested another call for volunteers to help organize BL2011
- Town Litter problem we discussed the proposed anti-litter initiative. The group agreed with John's suggestion to form a subcommittee to work on this
  - o Mike will get Dave Caron's direction on forming a subcommittee
  - SW members should attend their meetings and advise them
  - Identifying 2-3 locations for piloting anti-litter campaigns and signage was agreed to as one of the first initiatives to consider
  - Mike Town can help with purchase of anti-litter signs.
  - Dave Sid Kerr is a source on No Litter signage at West Rd.
  - Chief Hart is willing to help support and enforce the campaign
- John researched state litter programs. One is for limited access highways, the other for state secondary roads. Organizations need to agree to be sponsors, train and commit for 2 years
- Duane researched town / business recycling partnerships. We can discuss John & Duane's information next month.
