Acceptance of Minutes:

The revised minutes from the March meeting were reviewed and approved

- Paul and Gary discussed the organizational changes within the Beautify Londonderry (BL) subcommittee. The anti-litter subcommittee is now part of BL instead of being its own separate subcommittee. The first two weeks of BL will be the Roadside Pride concentrating on picking up litter. Litter pick up can also happen during the other scheduled BL events.
- Bob said that there was nothing new to report on the next RFP that will be going
 out within the year for the solid waste collection contract. Bob said that they did
 get contracts signed with the vendors that handle the pickup of materials from the
 drop off center. RMG got the contract for picking up the e-waste from the drop off
 center.

- Paul talked about the field visit to a single stream recycling plant at Casella's facility in Charlestown, MA. The committee is trying to set up a date for that visit. Hopefully it will be on a Friday or Saturday in May or June.
- Duane laid out the process for making edits to the meeting minutes so that there
 would an internal deadline for changes so the meeting minutes only need one
 revision. Duane will get the meeting minutes out to the committee members by
 the Monday after the SWEC meeting date and then the committee members will
 get any comments back to Duane by Thursday of the same week so that they
 can be issued to the Town for posting by Friday.
- Paul did speak with the Police Department regarding the pill take back box that
 was initially to be set up in the Police Station by this last fall. He was told that due
 to other needs that program was delayed until the end of 2015.
- Duane also brought in some pamphlets from the DES about products that say
 they are flushable but are not good for septic systems or sewer systems because
 they do not breakdown in water. Paul asked Duane to find an electronic flyer or a
 DES pamphlet that might be used on the Town website so the residents are
 aware of this matter.

Main Topics

Paul and Bob discussed the topic of using the drop off center as a location where
local businesses could drop off their fluorescent bulbs that contain mercury. Paul
handed out an action plan, timeline and a chart that compared the different types
of lamps. Bob stated that the presentation to the Town Council and Town
Manager is scheduled for late April or early May. Paul and Bob are planning
presentations to various business related groups to let them know of the new
program. The program is expected to be implemented in late June or July.
