Acceptance of Minutes:

 The committee finished discussing the new vs. relocation of a welcome sign as well as the relocation of the Welcome Sign at Exit 4 on Rt. 102. A new location about 200 feet west of where it is located now is being planned to provide for better visibility. The Town Manger needs to facilitate NHDOT approve this work. Trimmer's Landscaping has agreed to move the sign.
