- Paul said that Kirby Wade gave the committee an extension until December 15th to submit the committee's annual report. The committee reviewed the report, made some edits and told Paul to submit the revised report.
- The committee discussed membership issues and how can we get more citizens
 of Londonderry involved in the committee. Paul wrote up an advertisement on
