STREET NAMING TASK FORCE MEETING MINUTES July 19, 2011 Approved

Overview

Discussion welcoming Brian Johnson of Londonderry Fire Department as the newest member of the Task Force. Brian Johnson was appointed to the Task Force to fill the void caused by the resignation of Jim Bilodeau.

New Business

Karen Marchant advised that the Town Council inquired as to how much more time is needed for the Task Force to complete the renaming and renumbering of confusing/noncompliant street names in town. The best estimate of the task force is one to one and one-half years.

A consensus was reached by the Task force members present that the next two roads that need to be changed are Harvey Road and Kelley Road.

Harvey Road

John Vogl advised that the following changes need to be made to Harvey Road.

The section of Harvey Road from High Range Road to Pettengill Road to become a continuation of High Range Road.

The section of Harvey Road between Litchfield Road and High Range Road be renamed Skim Milk Road (Suggested name of Skim Milk Road taken from list of names previously provided by the Heritage Commission).

The section of Harvey Road from Grenier Field Road to the Manchester city line be renamed Grenier Field Road.

The Section of Harvey Road from Pettengill Rd to Grenier Field Road will be renamed and numbered to be a continuation of Pettengill Rd.

Kelley Road

A suggested name for Kelley Rd is Stage Coach Road also taken from a list of names previously provided by the Heritage Commission.

Date for a meeting with the property owners for the above mentioned road tentatively scheduled for August 11, 2011 at 7:00 P.M. in the Moose Hill Meeting Room of the Town Hall.

Other Business

The cost of postage associated with notifying owners was discussed. Due to the tight budget, a consultation with

The Town Manager is necessary to determine where the funds will come from to pay for this postage.
