OLD BUSINESS

Mammoth & Page Roads – Although this matter was tabled to October 5, 2015 meeting. Residents were present to discuss and make the committee aware of their concerns at this intersection. Public Works Director Czyzowski informed both residents and committee that new signs were put up alerting drivers on “Old” Mammoth Road of the upcoming stop. Deputy Chief Dussault advised both residents and committee that the Police Department has stepped up their enforcement of this intersection. Residents advised that vehicles are travelling too fast up Grenier Field to Mammoth, they have witnessed near accidents. This matter remains tabled to the October 5, 2015 meeting.

Hovey Road Cemetery – Ken Allen (not in attendance).

Route 102 @ High Range Road – Maureen Quillam (not in attendance). Public Works Director Czyzowski advised that he did have signs put up referencing the ducks crossing.

NEW BUSINESS

79 Hovey Road – Kerri Mulligan was present to advise the committee of the sharp on Hovey Road where she runs a Day Care Center. It is difficult for the parents to see around the curve and leave her driveway. Public Works Director Czyzowski advised that the Highway Department has cut trees to allow more of a site distance, however the area she is concerned about is private property. He suggested that she contact her neighbors to see if they would allow the brush to be cut back. She will be contacting her neighbors.

Meadow Drive – Ed Holms was in attendance advising the committee of the on-going problem of truckers travelling on Birchwood to turn around after finding out that they cannot get to the businesses on Meadow Drive. John Vogl GIS Manager/Comprehensive Planner for the Town of Londonderry was in attendance. He explained that per 911 regulations one end of Meadow Drive has to be renamed, this may help with this problem. The 911 renaming committee has been meeting since 2007, they are meeting again this week, renaming this street will be discussed. Town Councilor John Farrell appeared in the meeting and recommended that should this issue be brought before them, a solution to this problem must accompany this issue. Chairman Ramsay advised that this is not an issue for the Traffic Safety Committee, the outcome lies with the Town Council.
