39 40 41	TIM WININGS: The first two were that the plans be submitted to the Planning Board without a time restriction. The last one placed a time restriction on the application to the Planning Board.

Or the title passes 66 or what have you. 67 68 69 TIM WININGS: Yes, the shed sits on a temporary easement. It's actually the abutter's shed 70 and the length of the easement is basically his length of ownership. So as soon as the title 71 transfers by whatever means, the easement ceases to exist and the shed gets removed. 72 73 YVES STEGER: So essentially, your request here is to allow the shed to stay... 74 75 TIM WININGS: To stay within the buffer zone. 76 77 YVES STEGER: ...until... 78 79 TIM WININGS: Until the easement ceases to exist. 80 81 RICHARD CANUEL: We're gonna have the same discussion we had in the previous cases. 82 83 TIM WININGS: It's the same discussion that we just had. 84 85 RICHARD CANUEL: It's an existing accessory structure. It's allowed within the C.O. District. 86 It's allowed to remain. If it's an easement issue as part of the subdivision, then that's not for this Board's authority to decide on either. So, again, we have a situation where, you know, as I look 87 at the case, we don't have a case for a variance. 88 89
