Steve Small's report:

Arron Rich:

They will organize gym time grouped by ages; there will be no participation fee. Arron need to fill out the request for gym use form, and keep a running list of who is attending these open gyms. Mr. Valance will schedule the gym times as they fit into the school schedule. The open gym times will not take away from the upcoming spring sport, the adult men's gym time or any sport that is taking place sponsored by the Recreation Commission. The commission thanked Russ and Arron for doing this it will be great for the youth to be able to keep playing basketball during the off season.

New web based registration system:

• Luke brought information concerning various web services. This kind of service will enable Steve to track who has paid much more efficiently, have contact info, game schedules and allow parents to pay electronically for the sport programs. Steve felt this would be helpful to all involved. Vidal will bring this to the Select board to see if it is possible. The Town Treasurer will need to check into this also.
