

Town of Lyme
Board of Selectmen
Minutes for May 28, 2009

1. At 8:00 am Simon opened the meeting. The following attended all or parts of the meeting: Simon Carr (chair), Dick Jones (member), Charles Ragan (member), Dina Cutting (administrative assistant), Pauline Field (police chief), David Robbins (planning and zoning administrator) and Tim & Jessica Lahey.
2. Tim and Jessica came in to discuss traffic and pedestrian safety issues on the Dorchester Road through Lyme Center Village. They expressed concerns about vehicle speeding and the safety of children – particularly when waiting for, boarding and disembarking from the school bus. Pauline offered for the police to hold a safety education session for the village children. The Board referred them to discuss possible improvements with the Traffic Safety Committee (whose next meeting is June 11th), which would in turn make specific recommendations to the Board.
3. David came in to discuss two planning and zoning enforcement issues with the Board. It was agreed for him to write to Stella’s management giving a deadline of the end of June to line their parking lot. He advised the Board of RSA179:19 requirements for written permission for live entertainment. It was agreed that he would follow through to advise all Lyme establishments of this requirement.
4. The following administrative matters were discussed and actions taken:
 - a. The regular and both non-public sessions’ minutes of May 21st were approved as submitted.
 - b. The manifest was reviewed and signed.
 - c. The following yield tax assessments were made:

 - e. A new form for personnel performance reporting was reviewed and approved for Town employees other than police.
 - f. The “purchase and sales” agreement for Walter and Carole Young’s property on Mud Turtle Pond Road (map 407 lot 77) was reviewed and signed.
 - g. The Board discussed road and grounds maintenance issues and agreed not to reach any conclusions or take any action pending discussion with the Cemetery Commission, sexton and road agent.
