- 1. At 8:00 am Simon opened the meeting. The following attended the meeting: Simon Carr (chair), Dick Jones (member), Charles Ragan (member), Dina Cutting (administrative assistant) and Pauline Field (police chief).
- 2. The following administrative matters were discussed and actions taken:

Simon updated the Board on the Energy Committee, which is in the process of selecting a new co-chair, and the Town Offices Building Committee, which will no longer be holding its regular weekly meetings but continue to exist through the end of 1-year guarantee period on the new Town Offices construction.
- f. The Safety Committee's minutes were reviewed and discussed. Pauline agreed to follow up with the State on caution signage (pedestrians/school bus stop as appropriate) on the Dorchester Road through Lyme Center Village, and with the Highway Department on brush clearing to improve sight distances at selected road intersections.
- g. The Board approved Senator Shaheen's request to use the Town Offices main conference for her staff to meet with constituents on Monday, June 29th.
- h. The Board discussed handouts for next Wednesday's Budget Committee meeting on "Types of Designated Funds" and "Procedures in setting Town and School Tax Rates".
- i. The Board discussed drafts of a new "Fund Balance Policy" and the need for a policy on the use of the main conference room in the new Town Offices. No decisions were made on either policy.
- j. The Board discussed the parking situation at the northwest end of the Common, and Pauline agree to review the situation with the abutting business owners to work on a possible solution.
