Town of Lyme Board of Selectmen Minutes for August 13, 2009

- 1. At 8:00 am Simon opened the meeting. The following attended all or parts of the meeting: Simon Carr (chair), Dick Jones (member), Charles Ragan (member), Dina Cutting (administrative assistant), Pauline Field (police chief), Dan Quinn (transfer station supervisor) and Rod Finley (Pathways Consulting).
- 2. Rod came in to discuss the draft survey for the proposed Chaffee Sanctuary conservation easement. In addition, Rod reported the NHDES had determined that the Balch Field/Town Beach wetlands permit application was administratively complete.
- 3. The Board asked Rod to prepare the layout information requested by NHDOT for the realignment of the High Street-Route 10 intersection.
- 4. The following administrative matters were discussed and actions taken:
 - a. The minutes of the August 5th and 6th meetings and August 6th public hearing were approved with minor corrections.
 - b. The manifest was reviewed and approved.
 - c. Dick briefed the Board on Tuesday's UVLSRPC Transportation Advisory Committee meeting.
 - d. A yield tax abatement of \$431.08 for Richard Hoyt on map 407 lot 97 for storm damaged timber was approved.
 - e. Simon moved and Charles seconded a motion that no additional storm damage yield tax abatements be granted for storm damaged timber as a result of the April 2007 wind storm be granted. The motion carried unanimously.
 - f. Charles moved and Simon seconded a motion to accept the solid waste disposal proposal received after the initially proposed due date. The motion carried unanimously, and Dan agreed to review all four proposals.
 - g. The Board agreed to schedule a public hearing for 8:00 am on September 3rd for the possible designation of Trout Pond Lane and Mud Turtle Pond Road as "emergency lanes".
 - h. The Board discussed and approved the "Unallocated Fund Balance Policy".
- 5. The meeting adjourned at 9:15.
