## Town of Lyme Board of Selectmen Minutes for February 18, 2010

- 1. At 8:00 am Simon opened the meeting. The following attended all or parts of the meeting: Simon Carr (chair), Dick Jones (member), Charles Ragan (member), Pauline Field (Police Chief) and Patty Jenks (Town Clerk).
- 2. The following administrative matters were discussed and actions taken:
  - a. The minutes of February 11<sup>th</sup> were approved with the correction of a typo.
  - b. The manifest was reviewed and approved.
  - c. Dick briefed the Board on the most recent Planning Board meeting and Simon on the most recent Energy Committee meeting.
  - d. The Board briefly discussed a possible traffic order for the Dorchester Road during mud season and concluded that there was little beyond the existing seasonal weight limit posting that was permitted by state law.
  - e. The Board briefly discussed the Fisher Bridge and concluded that the next step was to hire a contractor to prepare a wetlands permit application for the repairs.
- 3. The Board discussed the Post Pond boat launch. Pauline pointed that it was laid out in 1971 (by the County Commissioners for public access to the great pond); the Town had retained jurisdiction over it as a Class V road, and that it had never been officially named. Simon moved and Charles seconded a motion to officially name it "Boat Launch Lane". The motion carried unanimously.
- 4. At 8:23 Simon moved and Dick seconded a motion to go into non-public session under the authority of RSA 91-A:3 II(c) "matters which, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person" to discuss an application for a hardship abatement and two personnel issues. The motion carried unanimously and the Board went into non-public session.
- 5. At 9:15 the Board returned to public session having voted that the minutes of the non-public session not be made available to the public by roll call vote.
- 6. The meeting adjourned at 9:15.
