Town of Lyme Board of Selectmen Minutes for June 18, 2010

- 1. At 10:00 AM Dick opened the reconvened meeting at the Town Offices. The following attended all or part of the meeting: Dick Jones (chair), Charles Ragan (member), Simon Carr (member), Pauline Field (Police Chief), Paul Hatch (NH DOS Homeland Security and Emergency Management Field Representative) and Dina Cutting (Administrative Assistant/Justice of the Peace).
- 2. Paul explained that this was a 50/50 grant from NH Homeland Security for the purchase of a radio repeater for each cruiser and a mobile data terminal for the second cruiser. The application had been made in April and the town portion of the funds had already been appropriated at Town Meeting.
- 3. Dick moved and Simon seconded that the Board accept the NH Homeland Security grant of \$5,792.40 for two radio repeaters and a mobile data terminal. The motion passed unanimously. The Board signed the necessary paperwork, which was notarized by Dina.
- 4. The revised draft for the economic statement was approved.
- 5. Simon raised the issue of payment to an individual for work in the cemetery. He moved and Dick seconded that, upon receipt of the completed appropriate documents, a one-time payment should be made to Lyn Cushman for his work in mowing in the cemetery. The payment to be made from the regular cemetery maintenance fund. The motion passed unanimously.
- 6. Charles reported briefly on the Dorchester Rd dump.
- 7. The meeting adjourned at 10:25 PM.
