- 4. Question of integration of Capital Reserve Com with our Maintenance Com.
- 5. The list of "to do" projects, repairs and jobs were reviewed, after a lengthy discussion the top 5 were identified:

1a. Roof repairs at the Lyme Center Academy Building

1b. Well installation at Town Office/Police and Pike House.

- 2. Drainage in police corner of parking lot to Pike house driveway.
- 3. Generator at Highway Garage (MW feels this is a life safety issue)

4. Fire Station energy issues. (It was reported Chief Hinsley has formed a committee to investigate options that will address this issue). The Building Maintenance Committee will wait for their recommendations).

The above list is the recommendation of this committee to the Selectmen for consideration in prioritized order.

- 7. It was noted some of the smaller repair items to be done at the Pike House and LCAB are regular maintenance and should be followed through with as maintenance items.
- 8. Frank noted the Library had reported they have funds to address the concerns on the list.
- 8. Followed was a discussion on the procedure this committee will follow pertaining to specs for various jobs, bidding, department head involvement, deciding on which jobs are done ect. Dina reported the Selectmen will reviewing the sample specs and decide what the procedure will be for this committee.
- 9. Frank recommended the Selectmen allocate money to order and have on hand a reference for all building codes. This will help not only this committee but the Zoning Board when questions come up concerning codes. Michael moved and Don seconded this recommendation. Voted unanimously in favor.
