We are waiting for more information regarding the grant to support part of the cost of the generator for the highway garage.

Frank noted that he was recently able to find a very good used generator for a project at Harvard Forest, for a saving of over \$10,000. The committee agreed that it would be very good to try and find an appropriate used generator that is in good shape for the town garage. Frank will look in this.
