- 1. We have \$6632.57 in the bank.
- 2. Lou presented the (long) application for the Sponsor a Highway program. We will review. It talks about sponsoring state maintained roads; would this include Center Road, our preferred choice? If not, Forest Road between the Wilton town line and Center Road might be an option.
- 3. Sharon thanks the Highway Department for their work keeping the parking lot at lower Purgatory Falls very clean.
- 4. Someone requested permission to camp in a tent near the lower Falls for one night. Unfortunately the town cannot grant this (liability issues). Should we develop a policy that would allow it?
- 5. The PLC closed on the second Proctor parcel in June. They plan to plant 30-40 trees and shrubs around Cold Brook in the next few weeks, to shade the brook.
- 6. Ms. Amanda Stone from the UNH Co-op Extension will be coming to the next meeting to talk about the Fish & Game Wildlife Plan and what the commission and the Extension can do to support it.
- 7. We are still working on the warrant articles, and want to have the text finalized at the October meeting.
- 8. The Community Day hike around Upper Purgatory Falls will start Saturday at 9:30.
