The total, \$1050, is the same as this year. The revised numbers reflect real and anticipated costs.

Since the plan is to combine the two commissions at the next town meeting, only costs of public notices and certified letters was requested, a total of \$90.

OTHER TOPICS TALKED ABOUT

Jessie brought the town's "Jury Box," used to select jurors until about 1970. It was found at Citizens' Hall and given to the Historical Society for safe keeping.

Several pictures of former Grange Past Masters were shown to be identified. One of them was not. Nadine Preftakes has suggested making a collage of the masters between 1936 and the closure of the Grange in the early 1970s to match the collage of the earlier masters.

The town office has requested that the pictures removed from the meeting room at Citizens' Hall be returned to the walls. Most of them belong to the Lafayette Artillery Company. All items at the hall belonging to the Historical Society will be removed in storage.

The Historical Society needs a permanent home. Clayton and Bob will do some research.

There should be a tree on the oval in front of the town hall. Several kinds were discussed and a Christmas tree was favored.

The next meeting was set for Thursday, January 30.
