7 p.m.: Stephanie opened the meeting at 7 p.m. The minutes of April 23, 2017, were approved on a motion by Bob, seconded by Stephanie. There was no treasurer's report.

JUNE 3 HISTORICAL SOCIETY PROGRAM

It will be an open house, show-and-tell program at the Town Hall from 1 to 4 p.m. The topic will be the update of the town history now in progress. Jessie will bring the Society's picture collection. It was discovered that the Town Hall stage is again filled with chairs, after Commission members spent over an hour last fall putting them all upstairs. A dozen of them will be offered for sale.

MONUMENTS COMMITTEE

The common is ready for Memorial Day except for rain-delayed finishing. Stephanie and Walter Holland have determined the size (16 by 18 inches) of the new plaques and they will be ordered. A pallet of bricks has been donated for the new walkway around the flag pole and those will be picked up. It was decided to complete the walk with blank bricks that can be replaced at a later date with memorials.

The new, shorter, flagpole, replacing the old one broken in a wind storm, looks good and is properly illuminated.

GLASS FACTORY SIGN

Scott and Stephanie constructed a planter around the sign using stones found on site. The town provided soil which was placed in the planter and flowers planted. They raked and cleared the surrounding bank but more work needs to be done, soil added and grass planted. The new larger sign has been ordered.

CLARK POTTERY SIGN

This will be discussed further after the new Glass Factory sign has been installed.

HOUSE SIGN UPDATE

No new ones have been ordered.

CITIZENS' HALL DISPLAY CASES

Chris Schoen has said the cases were receiving their final finish and he will call Jessie when they are to be installed.

LIBRARY STORAGE UPDATE

The area has been cleared of empty boxes, space needs determined, and measurements taken. Wally will construct the shelves. It is hoped to have all the Historical Society artifacts removed from their storage room before hot weather.

OTHER

Selectman Fred Douglas reported the Center sign appeared to be "skewed." Wally said it was probably caused by a wind storm and he will check it out.

Wally said the two shutters missing from the Center Church have been located. They will be put back when the window restoration work is complete.

Leo Trudeau will be contacted by the town office to be sworn in as an alternate.
