## Post meeting:

Email from Scott "Gio Analysis" dated: 4/7/16

As promised, I added a map showing the 5-mile drive radius for a fire station located at the corner of Center and Curtis Brook Roads. Total coverage: 549 houses, which is about 25 fewer than a hypothetical station located at Lyndeborough Center. The uncovered areas along Route 31 fall within Greenfield's coverage area (as well as within the coverage area of the current station), and some of the Turnpike is within Francestown's coverage area. But there are several houses on the back side of Mountain Road that would remain uncovered.

I also tested the Holt Road/Pinnacle Road site. Total coverage: 502 houses. By placing the station there, we lose Perham Corner and Tarn Road and still don't touch a small section of Mountain Road.

I added both maps to the Story Map (panels 16 and 17).
