- -Supporting technology (coordinate with the EOC, town office is looking at funding options for that) and space for that.
- -Furniture needs, power protection, air conditioning, individual lockers
- -Citizens' Hall paperwork (Donnie will get to Mr. Petrovick)
- -Generator upgrade, propane tanks
- -Vehicle storage
- -Town Meeting date...March 12
- -Other individuals involved.
- -Meet again in two weeks on the 22nd. Mike will bring drawings.

Citizens' Open Forum

TA Report:

- -Cartographics agreement:
- -Narrow band width radios. All switched over by January 1, 2013. Let's get some vendors to come in and make presentations. Kent needs 9 plus 2 portables. **ACTION...TA Bingham** will put on January agenda.
 - -Traffic count on Johnson Corner Road: NRPC scheduled traffic count on Johnson Corner. Newly paved and lots of traffic. Get accurate count to support revising our Haz Mat numbers.
- -Hazard Mitigation Grant Status: Being reviewed in the next two weeks. Key factor is the cost benefit piece and traffic counts are very important to support the grant review. These grants are highly competitive. **ACTION...TA Bingham** will try to schedule a couple of other roads for counts...possible Center and New.
- -Status of Forbearance Agreements: All in good shape but **ACTION...TA Bingham** will make phone calls to encourage the payments to continue.
- -Performance evaluations will be delivered to the Board on 12-22-10. **ACTION...TA Bingham** will speak with Officer Maxwell tomorrow to confirm that he (Officer Maxwell) will handle the performance evaluation for Mike Needham.

Non-public Session RSA 91-A: 3 II (b) Hiring

Selectman Brown moved to go into a non-public session regarding personnel under the provisions of Non-public Session RSA 91-A: 3 II (b). **Selectman Byam** seconded the motion, so moved.

VOTE: Selectmen Brown, Byam and Sawin voted in favor, and Selectman Brown declared the motion to have carried unanimously (3–0).

The Board then went into nonpublic session, as recorded separately, at 7:51 p.m. The Board returned to public session at 8:10 p.m.

Selectman Brown moved to hire Jeff Tarr as a Heavy Equipment Operator at a rate of \$16.00/hour. **Selectman Byam** seconded the motion, so moved.

VOTE: Selectmen Brown, Byam and Sawin voted in favor, and Selectman Brown declared the motion to have carried unanimously (3–0).

Old Business:

Highway Budget revision-revisit

There was a brief discussion of Highway revisions

RA Perry's salary was briefly discussed in terms of salary versus hourly and whether that is appropriate compensation. Road Agent is an appointed position with a 2 or 3 year term. Jim will confirm the term and make sure that **RA Perry** is sworn in.

There was a brief discussion of Recommended 2010 encumbrances

Generator: The generator is faulty and no longer servicing the town office. Due to the expense to repair, a new generator is required. **ACTION...TA Bingham** will be checking with Mark Weissflogg to see what the options are for replacement. This is a top priority due to potential emergency needs.

Non-public Session RSA 91-A: 3 II (a) Personnel

Selectman Byam moved to go into a non-public session regarding personnel under the provisions of Non-public Session RSA 91-A: 3 II (a). **Selectman Sawin** seconded the motion, so moved.

VOTE: Selectmen Brown, Byam and Sawin voted in favor, and Selectman Brown declared the motion to have carried unanimously (3–0).

The Board then went into nonpublic session, as recorded separately, at 9:15 p.m. The Board returned to public session at 11:00 p.m.

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Selectman Byam moved that Officer Maxwell turn over all pertinent information related to pending complaints against Donnie Sawin at **TA Bingham's** request. Additionally, if he fails to produce the complete file the Board directs **TA Bingham** to inform him that he is immediately suspended without pay until further notice. **Selectman Sawin** recused himself from the vote. **Selectman Brown** seconded the motion, so moved.

VOTE: Selectmen Brown and Byam voted in favor, and Selectman Brown declared the motion to have carried unanimously (2–0).
