1204 Center Road Driveway Application Discussion:

Jan Achterhof and Brian Giammarino joined the Board to discuss their application for a Driveway Permit at 1204 Center Road. The applicants and the Board reviewed the sight distances and discussed the reasons they would like to relocate their Center Road driveway to a different part of their property and have the proposed new entrance on Mountain Road. They agreed approval of the permit would be contingent on discontinuing the circular driveway on Center Road, as well as the correction of the water problem that the property currently creates on Center Road.

The Board and the applicants agreed the appropriate action is to appeal the Road Agent's denial of the permit to the Planning Board, which meets tomorrow night June 21, 2018, at 7:30 pm.

Library Parking Lot Driveway Permit:

Selectman Chamberlain advised he is working with State DOT in obtaining a Driveway Permit for the Library. Trustee Rogers was in attendance and provided historical information regarding the placement of the septic system and the fact the driveway has been in existence for over 100 years. Selectman Chamberlain will keep the Board and the Trustees informed of his progress in obtaining the permit.

Center Road paving Discussion:

T/A Boland advised the Board he has been in contact with the owner of Advanced Paving, William Gelinas and was advised the current allocation for shim for Center Road is predicted to accomplish what the Selectmen are expecting.
