## 1. Revised Fee Schedule

The Board adopted an additional appropriation of approximately \$100,000 from the Fund Balance in order to balance the budget and get the tax levy rate increase below 4% with the understanding that the Village would replenish the funds by increasing its fees. The fee review presented represents a Village-wide review of all fee rates, except Parking Permits and Day Camp, which were updated in February 2009. The Village staff looked at the Town of Mamaroneck, Village of Larchmont, City of Rye, Village of Port Chester, Village of Pelham and Village of Scarsdale as comparisons.

Mayor Savolt thanked Mr. Slingerland for all of the work done on revising the Fee Schedule, some of which has not been looked at in many years. A draft Schedule was discussed and agreed upon by the Board. It was noted that there are fees that are directly tied to the Code and those sections of the Code will need to be changed.
