Old Business:

- 1) Re detention basins at Maplemoor Golf Course. Rich Spoke with Rob Dozier from the County-nothing is happening now. We as a Village need to keep the pressure on the County.
- 2) Re: All Hazard Mitigation Plan. It should be submitted by March/April. We have shaved 2 months off the process
- 3) Re: funds at the County level of 500K and 2.5M. Norman spoke with CE Astorino: the 500K was for the whole County. The 2.5 Million was not overridden.

New Business:

- 1) 500K from Congressman Lowey-it is actually \$485K and is being used for repair of collapsing storm drains and catch basins on Rt 1, the redirecting of pooling water by Beach Ave. The 125K grant is being used for stream bank mitigation on the Beaver Swamp brook, and for floodproofing. The 400K from George Latimar is being used for the Jeff. Ave Bridge-Dan will check if this has been filed for.
- 2) FMAC to Coordinate with the BOT re proposed Flood Summit w/all senior legislators. What can we do to help organize this event? Rich/Dan to contact FEMA to see if they can get copies of the flood loss statements for all insured flood victims in the Village. We need to make a list of projects we need to fund.
- 3) RE FEMA grant program for raising homes. Nothing can be done at this point until our All Hazard Plan has been accepted. The one grant which does not need the grant in place is closed until 2012. At this point we are doing the utmost to finish the All Hazard Plan as quickly as possible. Once the Plan has been accepted Dan Sarnoff will be in charge of making sure all applications are done in a timely manner.
- 4) The Road to Nowhere. The RFP's will go out by Friday the 28th. The bids will be completed by 11/17. The project needs to be done before the temperature drops below 40 degrees.
