Old Business

- 1) FMAC Agenda for April 27, 2011 VM to adv if IMA's went out to Harrison, Scarsdale and Rockland Stormwater District 1 to use their Menzi Muckers . VM to advise.
 - a. Not yet. Have been focusing on budget, and other more urgent BOT matters.
- 2) The VM was to reach to the County again regarding the wing wall at the Anita Lane/Valley Terrace Bridge. Was this done? Rich to Contact Mike Coley at the County. VM to adv
 - a. Rich Contacted County and spoke with Mike Coley. They said they were working to repair and correct the wingwall rather inexpensively, and that they would be back in touch with us soon. Will call again.
- 3) Craig volunteered to be the liaison to the April 30 Clean up day. CC-please give the group an update.
 - a. Moving ahead. Looking like we'll have a good group of helpers. All are welcome. The more helpers we have, the more garbage we can clean-up and take out of the rivers.

 - a. Reached out; have not yet heard back, due to focus on the budget over past month.

- 2) During the last storms in New Jersey there was a spot on one of the news programs that the Passaic River had rec'd state funds for flood mitigation in addition to the study being done by the ACE. Is this something we should be more aggressively pursuing?
 - a. We've been pursuing it, but the limitations have been on the lack of a Hazard Mitigation Plan. We've begun working on the Hazard Mitigation Plan with ETG. Moving forward.
