## Minutes:

1. Meeting came to order at 7:35pm in the Regatta
2. Acting Village Manager Dan Sarnoff provided printed annotated comments to the meeting's agenda – this document is to be included as an appendix to these minutes. Discussion followed, with the notes below highlighting items not in Dan's write up:
  - a. Army Corps of Engineers plan:
    - i. The ACoE has requested a refreshed letter of intent from the Village which is being drafted and the board is expected to resend.
    - ii. Dan to ask if County has had a letter of support requested.
  - b. WJWW Dam
    - i. The committee continues to plan on discussing the valves further – and Dan intends to invite Terry O'Neil to a future FMAC meeting.
  - c. Vacuum truck:
    - i. Again, a spirited discussion on the topic.
    - ii. Trustee Waitt noted that the board has seen a recommendation for a certain truck and is assessing the business case for the purchase in context of operational plan and interplay with Cook contract.
    - iii. Dan to provide Cook's schedule of cleanings.
    - iv. Keith also suggested a board work session on the topic – and there is clearly more to discuss until a cohesive case is developed.
  - d. Tompkins Ave Bridge
    - i. Some new items were raised:
      1. the County requested a plan of action related to scouring
      2. a resident sent a picture of veneer falling away on the bridge
  - e. Community Rating System (CRS)

- i. Inspection scheduled for July.
- f. Water Quality
  - i. Dan spoke to Peter Linderoth and shared the welcome news that Save the Sound will plan to add a testing site at Winfield Ave / Braxmar.
- g. Dredging
  - i. Coordination underway to identify locations, then will spec out and go for bid.
- h. Finally, the minutes from the prior meeting were approved.
- i. There being no other business, the meeting concluded at 8:56pm.
