On motion of Trustee Robinowitz, seconded by Trustee Ryan:

RESOLVED that Proposed Local Law 2-2008 be and hereby is enacted as Local Law No. 2-2008 and shall read as follows:

LOCAL LAW NO. 2-2008

A Local Law known and cited as the Amendment to Parking Regulations of Chapter 326 of the Village Code.

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mamaroneck as follows:

SECTION 1. Purpose and Intent. The purpose of this local law is to clarify certain parking regulations.

SECTION 2. The Chapter 326 is hereby amended as follows:

- a) Amend section 326-39 (A) (3) to read: The northerly side of Bishop Avenue adjacent to the railroad track, beginning approximately 603 feet from the easterly side of Fenimore Road and extending easterly a distance of approximately 340 feet.
- b) Add a new subsection 326-39(A) (4) to read: The area on the southerly side of Bishop Avenue extending easterly from Maple Avenue a distance of approximately 245 feet.
- c) Add a new subsection 326-39(A) (5) to read: The northerly side of Bishop Avenue adjacent to the railroad track, beginning approximately 153 feet from the easterly side of Fenimore Road and extending easterly a distance of approximately 450 feet.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY. If a court of competent jurisdiction declares any portion of this local law illegal or unconstitutional such declaration shall not prevent the enforcement of any other portion of this local law.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State, and is subject to review and renewal by resolution of the Village Board for an additional period of time, effective immediately.
