CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Tannenbaum called the Regular Meeting to order at 7:35 p.m.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Remove two parking spaces on Plaza Avenue – held over – no new information.

Dr. Tannenbaum said that he needs additional information to assess and take action.

This has been resolved, Dr. Tannenbaum said.

Dunkin Donuts - sign

Dr. Tannenbaum said the sign was taken down.

Mr. Barney said that since he was not in attendance for the October meeting, and in reviewing the Minutes, is not in favor of the placement of a 'hump' on Barry Avenue near the bridge. Dr. Tannenbaum added that the hump is asphalt and about three to four feet wide.

Mamaroneck Beach & Yacht Club

A brief discussion was held on cabanas to be replaced with bungalows. There would be a Change of Use as it would be considered seasonal housing.

1. Highland Drive and Maple Avenue – speeding drivers use Highland as a short cut to Livingston Avenue and Fenimore Road. Residents would like Highland to be one way from Maple to Fenimore and Livingston Avenue entrance at 300 Livingston Avenue blocked. Letter sent to Police Chief.

Dr. Tannenbaum said that the road is bumpy and like an alley. There were complaints of speeding. The Commission members who visited the location said they saw very little traffic. It is a two-way street. The proposal is to make it one way from Maple to Fenimore Rd. The block is long it was noted.
