# DRAFT VILLAGE OF MAMARONECK BOARD OF TRAFFIC COMMISSIONERS THURSDAY, OCTOBER 8, 2015

Mr. Yannuzzi called to order the meeting at 7:30 p.m.

#### **Old Business**

Mr. Yannuzzi met with the Village Manager and discussed the following:

- North Barry Avenue detour
- Fenimore Road and Palmer Avenue signs
- Halstead Avenue taxi stand updates
- Add sidewalk on Halstead Avenue by train station, option would be to move over double yellow lines. Trustee Potok said this matter will be discussed at their next Work Session.

#### **New Business**

#### 1. Traffic on Bleeker Avenue (Resident)

The Board members discussed. Mr. Yannuzzi said it is an enforcement issue. No action taken.

#### 2. Over the Bridge on Rockland Avenue at Waverly Avenue – Sidewalk Extension

Mr. Tannenbaum said that the sidewalk should be extended as it ends abruptly. The Village Engineer should look into. The Board members agreed that this work should me done.

On motion of Mr. Tannenbaum, seconded by Mr. Zagajeski, the Traffic Commissioners recommended that the Village Engineer look at the sidewalk over the bridge on Rockland Avenue at Waverly Avenue. Motion passed unanimously.

# 3. Parking on Waverly between Plaza and Fenimore – (See Backup)

Mr. Yannuzzi said that the following options should be considered:

- limit commercial parking at night
- consider day parking time limits, e.g., 4 hours
- put meters on Village revenue
- no overnight parking

Mr. Spedafino stated that taxi cabs should not be parking there all day. It was noted that Blue Bird, Paramount and others were seen parking all day.

Officer Gaglione mentioned that taxis are regulated by their own commission.

Trustee Potok said he will speak to Paramount and Plaza. He suggested that the area be looked at randomly late at night.

Put on November agenda.

# 4. No overnight parking in the Village – (See Backup)

The Board discussed and agreed that this will not occur. No action taken.

# **5.** Car rental on Nostrand – (See Backup)

Enterprise Car rental is at this location. The Board discussed cars being backed out for rental causing congestion, and agreed it is an enforcement issue. No action taken.

# 6. 'No Through Traffic' One-Way Portion of Maple and Livingston from Prospect to Livingston

The Board members discussed and agreed that no action be taken.

# 7. Parking before CVS Driveway Westbound on the Northern Section of East Boston Post Road

Mr. Tannenbaum said that Healthy Fit fitness center is located next to CVS. There are about 15 parking spots available, and approximately 300 members who belong to the fitness center. There is inadequate parking. Line of sight is hindered due to the volume of cars.

On motion of Mr. Tannenbaum, seconded by Mr. Figliomeni, a 'Parking Prohibited' sign to be put up on the north side of East Boston Post Road from Harrison Avenue to the CVS driveway. Motion passed unanimously.

## 8. Notify Residents of Changes Before They Occur

The Board members discussed. Village meetings are posted on the Village website. No action taken.

# 9. Request to Make Center between Rockland and Concord one Way towards Concord

Mr. Yannuzzi said he went with the Village Manager to the site. There is pedestrian traffic including high school children. The issue is that trucks pull up looking for access to I-95. Mr. Yannuzzi suggested making Center Avenue one way coming down. A one-way sign to be put up on Center Avenue from Rockland Avenue to Concord Avenue, a directional sign on Concord Avenue out to Waverly Avenue noting I-95. An I-95 emblem sign to be put up on both sides. The Board members discussed and agreed this is necessary.

On motion of Mr. Tannenbaum, seconded by Mr. Figliomeni, directional signs at Concord Avenue and Center Avenue to turn Left to Waverly Avenue, at Waverly Avenue, a sign to turn Left to Fenimore Road. At Fenimore Road, a sign to turn Right to Hoyt Avenue, at Hoyt Avenue a sign to turn Left to I-95. An emblem I-95 sign to be put up on both sides. Motion passed unanimously.

#### 10. Lester Avenue one-way from Hillside Avenue to Nostrand Avenue – (See Backup)

Mr. Yannuzzi said he met with the Village Manager on this matter that the detour signs were not put up correctly at Hillside Avenue. The Village Manager recommended a one-way sign.

Mr. Spedafino moved to approve a One-Way Sign on Lester Avenue from Hillside Avenue to Nostrand Avenue, seconded by Mr. Zagajeski. Motion passed unanimously.

#### 11. 1015 Old Post Road – Orienta Gardens – Paint parking lines (Pictures Attached)

Mr. David Salko, resident, discussed adding additional parking at Orienta Gardens. The Board members reviewed options and agreed that two parking spaces be added toward Cooper Avenue after the last parking space, and two more spaces from the last car that is parked opposite Cooper Avenue toward Old Post Lane.

Mr. Zagajeski, seconded by Mr. Spedafino, moved to approve two parking spaces to be added toward Cooper Avenue after last parking space, and two parking spaces from last car parked opposite Cooper Avenue toward Old Post Lane. Motion passed unanimously.

#### 12. Gertrude Avenue Parking in front of Mamaroneck Avenue School (Pictures Attached)

Mr. Yanuzzi said a resident came to the meeting last month regarding the loss of six parking spaces in front of the school. Mr. Yannuzzi said the Village Manager advised that the six parking spaces are school district spaces. No action taken.

# 13. 326.76 and 326.88-1 - Sand Street vs. Sands Street in Village Code

Mr. Kerr stated that upon his research the street name is Sand. Village Code to be changed.

On motion of Mr. Kerr, seconded by Mr. Spedafino, in Village Code 326.76 and 326.88-1, Sand Street was incorrectly spelled. Change to be made in Village Code. Motion passed unanimously.

#### 14. 326.80, 326.86, and 326.88-1. Louise Avenue vs. Louise Street in Village Code-.

Mr. Kerr researched the Village Code and found that the roadway is named Louise Avenue. The Village Code is to be changed to correct the error from Louise Street to Louise Avenue.

On Motion of Mr. Kerr, seconded by Mr. Spedafino, in Village Code 326.80, 326.86 and 326.88-1, Village Code to be changed to Louise Avenue. Motion passed unanimously.

#### 15. 326.76 Direction of Travel signs on Elliot Avenue and Ralph Avenue

The Board discussed and agreed that this be placed on the November agenda.

#### Other

#### 326.88-1 - Louis Street - Street Cleaning Hours.

Mr. Kerr stated that 'No Parking' signs should be put up as follows: No parking from 9 AM to 12PM First Thursday of Month on the west side of Louis Street and for the entire length, and No Parking First Friday of the month on the east side of Louis Street and for the entire length. The Board discussed and agreed that signs should be put up.

On motion of Mr. Kerr, seconded by Mr. Spedafino, change Code to add 'No Parking' signs to be put up on Louis Street as follows: No Parking from 9 AM to 12 PM First Thursday of Month on the west side of Louis Street for the entire length, and No Parking from 9 AM to 12 PM First Friday of the month on the east side of Louis Street for the entire length. Motion passed unanimously.
