VILLAGE OF MAMARONECK
BOARD OF TRAFFIC COMMISSIONERS
THURSDAY, MARCH 10, 2016

PRESENT: Chairman Myron Tannenbaum, Brian Kerr, Joe Mazzullo
Ed Zagajeski, John Figliomeni, Abby Roberts, Kelly Wenstrup

Chairman Tannenbaum called to order the meeting at 7:30 p.m.

Old Business

1. 'No Parking from here to Corner' sign at Hunter Street and Park Avenue

Mr. Figliomeni and Mr. Kerr stated that they went over to the location at separate times and both saw vehicles parked to the corner. Mr. Mazzullo recommended that there be no parking on all four corners to 15 feet in on Hunter Street and Park Avenue. The Board agreed.

On motion of Mr. Mazzullo, seconded by Mr. Figliomeni, four "No Parking Here to Corner" signs be put on at Hunter Street and Park Avenue fifteen feet in from the corner. Motion passed unanimously.

New Business

1. Trucks Hitting Railroad Bridge

Mr. Tannenbaum said that trucks hitting the bridge occurs mostly during the day. Mr. Kerr said that trucks going in a northerly direction on Mamaroneck Avenue from the Harbor is problematic.

Mr. Mazzullo remarked that the bridge fits in with the landscape and needs to stand out to draw attention to truckers.

Mr. Tannenbaum said that fluorescent yellow strips on the sides facing traffic and to have chevrons go all the way up should raise awareness.

Mr. Kerr said painted markings on the road stating Low Bridge can be helpful.

Mr. Tannenbaum stated that the MTA has jurisdiction over the bridge. He said the Traffic Commission will recommend to the Board of Trustees to get the MTA involved.

Mr. Mazzullo discussed solar powered signage that has been effective elsewhere and could be put on each side of the bridge. The panels would be positioned toward the sun.

Mr. Tannenbaum said they will make a recommendation to the Board of Trustees based on their discussions.

Ms. Wenstrup suggested that the Fenimore Road bridge be included. The Board members agreed.

On motion of Mr. Kerr, seconded by Mr. Figliomeni, the Traffic Commission discussed effective solutions to minimize trucks hitting the Mamaroneck Avenue bridge and Fenimore Road bridge and that discussions with an MTA representative should be initiated to alleviate future damage and disruption. Motion passed unanimously.

2. Eliminate Parking on Frank Avenue (attached resident concern, as per Mr. Slingerland)

The Board discussed and determined that no action be taken.

3. Commuter Parking on Fenimore Road between Palmer and Bishop Avenues - resident)

Discussions ensued. It was determined that no action be taken by the majority.

4. “No Parking Here to Corner” Keeler Avenue – resident

The Board members discussed and agreed that it is a valid request.

On motion of Mr. Figliomeni, seconded by Mr. Kerr, a ‘No Parking Here to Corner’ sign be put up west bound fifteen feet in from corner on the north side on Keeler Avenue. Motion passed unanimously.

Other

- No crosswalk for children walking home on Mamaroneck Avenue and North Barry Avenue. Mr. Figliomeni stated that this is a busy intersection with many popular businesses such as Valvoline Oil, Shell gas station, dry cleaners, etc.

- Mr. Tannenbaum said that a resident raised a concern about coming out of Crown Court near Raleigh Road, and making a left at Knollwood Avenue. There are visibility issues. Place on April agenda.

Minutes

1. Draft February Minutes

On motion of Mr. Zagajeski, seconded by Mr. Mazzullo, the minutes of February 11, 2016 were approved as corrected. Motion passed unanimously.

Adjournment

On motion of Mr. Figliomeni, seconded by Mr. Mazzullo, the meeting was adjourned at 8:15 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
