A roll call vote was taken with all members voting aye.

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

At a previous meeting a request from DPW Superintendent Rob Zora regarding DPW vehicles was discussed and not approved. Mr. Zora was present to discuss a revised request and after discussion the selectmen agreed that the employee would be allowed to use his personal vehicle for weekend calls, a "Town of Marion" magnetic sign will be affixed to the side of the vehicle, and the police department will be informed whenever he is responding to a weekend call (this will allow the police to answer any questions a resident might have when they see a private vehicle arrive at their property.) Mr. Dawson will verify that this arrangement is acceptable to the Town's liability insurance company.
