Appointment for discussion regarding 40 proposed minor changes to an Order of Conditions (File No SE 041-1170/SE 041-789) to the 41 footprint of the proposed future building, the parking lot expansion area and an oil/water separator 42 manhole in the proposed building. Rich Riccio of Field Engineering represented Jay Hiller who was 43 also present. N. Hills said the work basically repositioning the building and thought the changes 44 were minor and could be accepted by a letter rather than amending the Order of Conditions; the 45 other members agreed. J. Hartley drafted. N. Hills moved to send; C. Trinidad seconded; voted 46 unanimously.

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48 7:20 PM JOHN P. AND MALLORY Y. WATERMAN, Water Street Notice of Intent (File 49 No. SE 041-1213) to reconstruct the wooden pier and repair or reconstruct the stone seawall 50 (continued from May 14, 2014 due to Department of Marine and Fisheries comment about not 51 enough water under the float). N. Hills reported that the Harbormaster said there is 4' depth. J. 52 Doubrava moved to close; S. Gonsalves seconded; voted unanimously. N. Hills drafted the Order of 53 Conditions.

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55 7:30 PM MARSHALL AND WILMA BAILEY, 41 Dexter Road – Notice of Intent (File 56 No. SE 041-1214) to remove the existing licensed boardwalk/pier, gangway and float; construct a 57 new 3.5' x 130' boardwalk/pier, 4' x 24' gangway and 10' x 16' float; and separate and relocate the 58 two existing sheds onto new sono-tube foundations. (continued from May 14, 2014). D. Davignon 59 was delayed and asked to continue to a later in the meeting. S. Gonsalves seconded; voted 60 unanimously.

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62 **BAYBERRY LANE** D.E.P. advised of wetlands complaint. A site visit was made. A metal 63 post has been cemented into the middle of the walkway. N. Hills said they should have applied for a 64 permit to set the post. Allegedly the post was set by the landowner. It was agreed to draft an 65 Enforcement Order . N. Hills moved; C. Trinidad seconded; voted unanimously. Also, stones were 66 set at the end of the path and plant slash was dumped, and he should have cleaned up.

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68 7:40 PM PAUL E. GROVER, 24 West Drive – Request for Determination of Applicability 69 (File No. 41D-1530) to replace two existing decks with one continuous wrap-around deck, and replace landscaping shrubs with a planter. Mr. Grover was present with his Engineer David 70 71 Davignon, who described the proposed work. The deck will be on sono-tubes. a silt fence will be set 72 50' from the top of coastal bank (the seawall). The height of the deck will not change. The planter 73 will be 15" high, increasing to 42" as the elevation changes but is of a breakaway construction that is

74 approved by D.E.P. Excavated fill will be placed in the planter; minimal fill is expected. S. 75 Gonsalves moved to close; C. Trinidad seconded; voted unanimously.

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77 7:47 PM MARSHALL AND WILMA BAILEY Hearing was reopened from earlier. Mr. 78 and Mrs. Bailey were present with their Engineer, David Davignon. There is a change to the shed 79 from the NE side of the house to against the house. The shed will be as low as possible and have a 80 ramp instead of steps. D. Davignon said the Harbormaster is okay with 24" under the float rather 81 than 30" suggested by D.M.F. The first leg of the pier is shifted counter clockwise slightly 82 southeastly to avoid the flagpole. D. Davignon said a 20' section of the pier will be of a grated 83 material due to the pier being lower in that section, to minimize shading. J. Doubrava moved to 84 close; C. Trinidad seconded; voted unanimously.

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## **DISCUSSION: MARION OPEN SPACE ACQUISITION COMMITTEE (MOSAC),**

Grassi Bog, Mill Street (File No. SE 041-1197). In 2013 the MOSAC modified the dikes in the bog 88 which has been seriously damaged by the recent 5" and 2 " rainstorms. J. Hartley suggested 89 90 notifying the MOSAC for a better plan. N. Hills will.

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92 **DISCUSSION: MARION RECREATION DEPARTMENT**, Washburn Park. (File No. 93 41D-1488 to restore the picnic area by skating pond is valid until November 30, 2015). D.E.P. 94 received a complaint of wetlands violations. N. Hills said part of what was done, adding sand to 95 make a beach would not be allowed. N. Hills did an inspection with Paul Dawson and Recreation 96 Director Jody Dickerson, and no one knew who did the work. C. Trinidad agreed that an 97 Enforcement Order is needed.
