20           Meeting convened at 7:00 PM on Wednesday, January 27, 2016 in the conference  
21   room of the Marion Town House, 2 Spring Street, Marion, Massachusetts. Site visits were  
22   held on Saturday, January 23, 2016 by J. Doubrava and N. Hills. This meeting was televised  
23   and video recorded by Old Rochester Community Television (ORCTV), and audio recorded  
24   by Town of Marion staff.

26           **7:00 PM            Marion Recreation Department.** Update on Enforcement Order for  
27   File No. 41D-1488 for work at Washburn Park. Mark Manganello of LEC Environmental was  
28   present. LEC Environmental was hired by the town to prepare restoration plans for  
29   disturbed areas at Washburn Park. He described the first draft plans. The BVW line was  
30   done in August of 2014. In the summer of 2014 N. Hills met with M. Manganello and Paul  
31   Dawson, Town Administrator at the site. M. Manganello said that they were proposing to  
32   replace wetland top soil and put in some seed mixes along the area that was disturbed at  
33   the shore line of the pond. The types of mixes were listed on the proposed plan. There were  
34   some areas that vegetation had been cut down. Those areas would be allowed to grow  
35   back. M. Manganello suggested that the Commission do a site inspection in the Spring to  
36   see what type of vegetation has returned and if that would impact the plan of restoration.  
37   The second draft plan showed the proposed mowing areas. There was a brief discussion of  
38   the areas to be mowed and the importance of keeping the space accessible for  
39   recreational purposes. The outlet structure was also discussed. An operations and  
40   maintenance plan will be submitted with the final plans. M. Manganello will contact the

41 Commission when new plans are complete and will schedule a discussion. The work will be  
42 done under the Enforcement Order.

44 Minutes from January 13, 2016 were approved.

46 ZBA request for comments on Case # 718, Garrett Bradley: The property is not within  
47 the Commission's jurisdiction therefore there were no recommendations made.

49 N. Hills motioned to approve the payment of \$60.00 for the M.A.C.C. membership for  
50 the new Associate Member, Kristen Saint Don. J. Doubrava seconded; voted unanimously.

52 N. Hills motioned to issue the Partial Certificate of Compliance for **Elizabeth &**  
53 **Douglas Leatham**, File No. SE41-177, for 22 River View Lane (Map 9, Lot 65). J. Doubrava  
54 seconded; voted unanimously.

56 N. Hills motioned to issue the Partial Certificate of Compliance for **David & Patricia**  
57 **Pimental**, File No. SE41-177, for 2 West River Road (Map 9, Lot 94). S. Gonsalves seconded;  
58 voted unanimously.

60 A draft letter to Eagle Holt Company was discussed regarding repairs that are  
61 needed for the deterioration of the dike at the pond at Washburn Park. N. Hills motioned to  
62 send the letter; J. Doubrava seconded; voted unanimously.

64 The Commission received a request for comments from the Board of Selectmen  
65 regarding an Application for Aquaculture for Christopher Bryant. Mr. Bryant will be required  
66 to file a Notice of Intent. A memo will be sent to the Board of Selectmen.
